EMPLOYMENT

The \$3.5 billion Victorian Desalination Project will create a wide range of exciting job opportunities.

During the construction phase, the project is expected to create as many as 1700 direct jobs, many of them for labour and trades.

AquaSure's design and construction contractor for the project, Thies Degrémont, is looking for motivated and enthusiastic people to join its team.

Local applicants in particular are strongly encouraged to apply.

What types of jobs will be available?

There will be all kinds of jobs available – ranging from engineering and professional roles to trades and labour.

There may also be jobs available with various subcontractors involved with the project. They will conduct their own recruitment processes, providing even more employment opportunities.



When will jobs be available?

All available jobs will be advertised on the Thies Degrémont website as the project progresses and particular skills are needed on site.

On the plant site, it is expected that workforce numbers on site will increase rapidly during the first half of 2010, reaching a peak in November.

This peak workforce will be maintained through to around July 2011. Staff numbers will then decrease progressively until completion of the project in December 2011.
