# WORKS NOTIFICATION

Thiess Degremont, design and construction contractor, advises that the following works are about to be commence as part of the Victorian Desalination Project.

DATE OF NOTIFICATION	31 August 2010
WHAT'S HAPPENING?	<p>72 Dual Media Pressure Filters (DMPF) vessels will be progressively transported from Melbourne to the plant site over the coming months.</p> <p>The vessels will be transported at night as large overdimensional loads, escorted by support vehicles.</p> <p>The DMPF vessels are large filtration units, used to remove very fine particles from seawater.</p>
WHEN?	Transportation of the vessels will begin this week and continue through to December 2010.
WHERE?	The vessels will be transported from Melbourne to the plant site along a pre-approved route for over-dimensional loads.
WHAT'S INVOLVED?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The vessels will be transported at night in off-peak hours to minimise impacts on local traffic</li> <li>• The vessels will be transported as over-dimensional loads, escorted by pilot vehicles and traffic control teams</li> <li>• 72 vessels in total will be transported, generally 2 at a time</li> <li>• Each vessel weighs 54 tonnes and measures 15.1m x 5.2m</li> <li>• All required approvals are in place to transport the vessels</li> </ul>
